### **Preliminary Supply List**

This class is designed to use everyday materials you probably have around the house. I will give more specific details for each one as we get closer to the class, but you will need an assortment of the following items:

- Drawing paper (copy/printer paper is great)
- Pencil, black sharpie, favorite drawing tools
- Scrap paper in different colors (recycled or decorative papers, scrapbook paper, magazine pages, newsprint or text, wrapping paper, etc.)
- Glue stick, scissors
- An optional supply is to order a Spoonflower Color Map in advance so you can get it in time for class. Choose any fabric base that you want.
