



NTQM FIELD TRIP Friday 4/26/19 to Dolores Slowinski's Home Studio

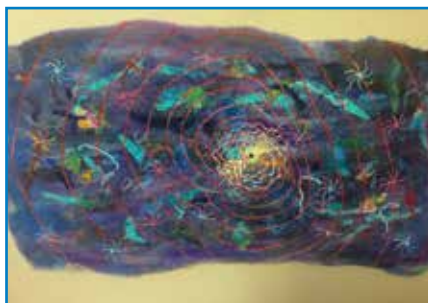


Our April excursion took us on a visit to a hidden gem in southwest Detroit.
